

PLYMOUTH TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS

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Minutes of the March 4, 2024 Meeting

The regular monthly meeting of the Plymouth Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 6:00 P.M. by Chairman James Murphy. Supervisors, Joseph Yudichak and Thomas Kachurak; and Secretary/Treasurer, Steven Grzyski, were also present. Solicitor, Eugene Kelley was absent.

February Meeting Minutes: Since the minutes were posted for inspection prior to the meeting, *it was moved by Mr. Yudichak, seconded by Mr. Kachurak, to dispense with the reading and to accept the minutes as presented from the meeting on February 5, 2024. Motion passed 3-0.*

Bill List: Since it was posted for inspection prior to the meeting, *it was moved by Mr. Yudichak, seconded by Mr. Kachurak, to dispense with the reading of the bill list and to accept it as presented. Motion passed 3-0.*

Treasurer's Report: Since it was posted for inspection prior to the meeting, *it was moved by Mr. Yudichak, seconded by Mr. Kachurak, to dispense with the reading of the treasurer's report and accept it as presented. Motion passed 3-0.*

Code Enforcement Officer: No formal report, however, Mr. Grzyski did note that Barry Isett & Associates Inc. sent three (3) Notice of Violation letters and issued a Notice of Citation to the resident on Cool Street with the property maintenance/building code issues.

Zoning Officer: No zoning permits issued in February.

Fire Companies: Mr. Mark Boncal, City of Nanticoke Fire Chief, informed the Supervisors that the new hydrant at the intersection of West Main Street and Mooney Road was installed during the month of February. Mr. Boncal also relayed that the Nanticoke Career Firefighters Local 2655 is holding a charity golf tournament to benefit Foundation 58 on Friday, May 24, 2024 at Sand Springs Gold Course. All proceeds go to Foundation 58 and their mission in helping all first responders with medical conditions related to their job duties. Finally, Mr. Boncal stated that a public meeting will be held at Nanticoke City Hall on Thursday, March 7, 2024 at 5:00 PM with the Luzerne County Council and Manager; potential discussion points regard the state of the Nanticoke/West Nanticoke Bridge and its future.

Road Department: Mr. Vince Wysowski noted that the road department cleared the township roads of snow/ice from the winter storms and patched potholes during the month of February. Mr. Wysowski also signaled their intention to pave the bottom of West Mountain Road during paving season.

Lower South Valley COG: Mr. Grzymiski stated the Lower South Valley COG will meet on Wednesday, March 13, 2024 at the Earth Conservancy at 10:00 AM.

Storm Water Awareness: Mr. Wysowski said that the road department removed leaves and debris from catch basins throughout the township to alleviate ponding in February.

Engineer's Report: No formal report but Mr. Grzymiski did note that Borton-Lawson Engineering sent a letter to DCED wishing to extend the EDCDI grant to June 30, 2025. Borton-Lawson will also hold a pre-construction meeting on Wednesday, March 6, 2024 at 10:00 AM with the awarded contractor for the Mill Street Sewer Extension Project and will hold a pre-bid meeting with interested contractors for the Sewer Rehabilitation Project at 11:00 AM on the same day.

Sewer Collection: Mr. Grzymiski: sewer fees collected to date (1/1/24 – 2/29/24): \$13,085.86.

Solicitor's Report: No report, Mr. Kelley was not present.

Old Business: No old business was brought before the Board.

New Business: No new business was brought before the Board.

Public Comment: No public comment was brought forth by those in attendance.

Adjournment: There being no further business to come before the Board, *it was moved by Mr. Yudichak, seconded by Mr. Kachurak, to adjourn the meeting at 6:07 P.M. Motion passed 3-0.*
